

## **Bus connections**

Dear conference participant

If you choose to take the bus to get from your hotel to the Conference Centre (or vice versa), this sheet will help you find your way:

### **Hotel Stadt Hannover**

Walk to “Markt” (follow Goethe Allee – it turns into Prinzenstraße – then turn left into Gothmarstraße, the bus stop is right down the street). Take bus no. 73 to “Keplerstraße”. From there, it is another 300m to the Conference Centre.

### **Renschuh Hotel**

Get on the bus at “St.-Heinrich-Straße” (follow Kasseler Landstraße, turn right into Siekweg at the big auto repair shop – you will pass a KFC on the way – walk up the street to the bus stop at the corner). Take bus no. 31 and go to “Jüdenstraße”. There, change busses to no. 71 or 72 and get off at “Am Steinsgraben”. Walk another 200m to get to the Conference Centre.

### **Leine Hotel**

Walk up the road for about 200m to the bus stop called “Posthof”. Take bus no. 31 to “Jüdenstraße”, change to bus no. 71 or 72 and get off at “Am Steinsgraben”. The Conference Centre is 200m away.

### **Astoria**

Walk 200m up the road. Your bus stop is called “Grüner Weg” (right across the street from McDonald’s). Take bus no. 32 or 62 to “Weender Straße West”. Get on bus no. 12 (it stops at “Weender Straße West” as well) and go to “Hiroshimaplatz / Neues Rathaus”. It is less than 300m to the Conference Centre.

### **Hostel 37**

Walk 180m towards Groner-Tor-Straße, to the bus stop called “Groner Tor/Hirtenbrunner”. Take the bus no. 21 to Zietenterrassen and go to “Leibnizstraße”. The Conference Centre is 100m away.

## **Jugendherberge**

Walk 150m towards Ewaldstraße, and reach the bus stop called “Jugendherberge”. Take the bus no. 80 towards Leineberg and go to “Theaterstraße”. From there, turn left and go to the stop “Jüdenstraße”. Take the bus no. 71 or 72 and get off at “Am Steinsgraben”. Walk about 200m to get to the Conference Centre.

You can buy the tickets directly from the bus driver (cash only). A single ticket is 2,30€. A day ticket for 5,50€ allows you to use any number of buses in one day. Or you may get a “Viererticket”. This consists of basically four single tickets that you can use at your convenience. It's 8,00€ and therefore cheaper than buying four individual tickets. Just make sure to validate each ticket as you use it.
